2018 Judicial Preference Poll

The Columbus Bar Association's annual Judicial Preference Poll closed for voting at noon on October 25, 2018. This information is not intended as an endorsement for candidates but as a service to help voters make an informed decision when voting for judicial candidates.

There are seven contested judicial races being decided on November 6 in Franklin County for seats on the Franklin County Common Pleas Court- General and Domestic Divisions. Earlier this month, central Ohio attorneys were asked to indicate the candidate they preferred in each race. Polling ballots were sent to 7,505 attorneys in Franklin County and a total of 787 votes were cast. The poll was conducted online by Votenet Solutions and a statement included with the ballot requested that attorneys without "sufficient current knowledge or information about the candidates" abstain from voting in the poll.

The Columbus Bar conducts two polls each year in an effort to provide merit-based, non-partisan information to voters about the elected judiciary. The preference poll of judicial candidates is conducted each fall. A performance poll of sitting judges is conducted each spring. Results of both polls and findings of the Judicial Screening Committee are available at **JudgeTheCandidates.org**, our non-partisan voter education portal designed to help voters make informed decisions at the ballot box.
